

Literacy

The children will be continuing practising their sounds and blending them into words. They will be introduced to more high frequency words to practise (eg. said, they).

What you can do at home:

Try to share a book with your child as often as you can. This can be their reading book to read to you or reading a picture book at bed time etc.

Encourage your child to practice writing – writing their name, can they write a shopping list, labels for their toys etc.

What you can do at home:

Expressive Art and Design

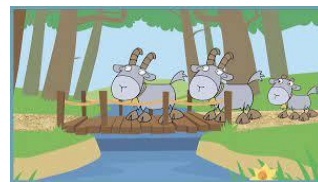
