Can you describe their properties? E.g. flexible, durable, malleable.</p>	<p>Tell us all about 'you'. This could be your favourite hobbies, clubs or ambitions. This can be presented any way you would like e.g. diary, comic strip, photos, song.</p>
<p>Create a rap that helps you remember the planets and their order in the Solar System.</p>	<p>Create a map of your local community. This could be your route to school or journey to your favourite place.</p>	<p>Choose a famous person from the Tudor era (it cannot be Henry VIII). Why are they significant? What did they achieve? What impact did they have?</p>
<p>Do you have a favourite artist? Who are they? What type of art do they produce? Can you recreate a piece of their artwork?</p>	<p>Research the uses of cams and followers. What are they?
