Go on a minibeast hunt in your garden or at the park. What minibeasts can you spot?	Play a board game with your family. Practise taking turns and playing fairly.	Plant a sunflower seed. Measure how tall it gets.
Have a go at colour mixing. What colours can you create using red, blue and yellow?	Visit Gloucester Museum.	Can you write the numbers 1-10 in different ways, e.g. chalks, in shaving foam, paints, water with paintbrush outside.
Paint or draw a picture of your favourite animal or minibeast.	Listen to a variety of music. Which style do you like best? How does it make you want to move? How does the music make you feel?	Make biscuits or bake some cakes with your grown up.
Write a sentence about your favourite animal.	Use your toys to create number pairs to 5 and 10. e.g. 2 cars and 3 trucks make 5 altogether.	Read your favourite story book.
